

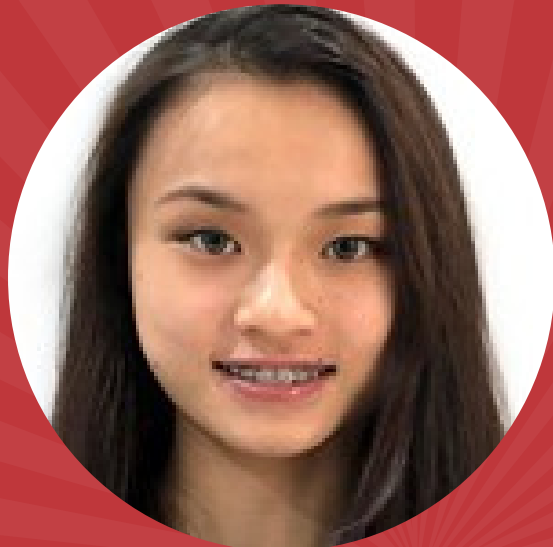

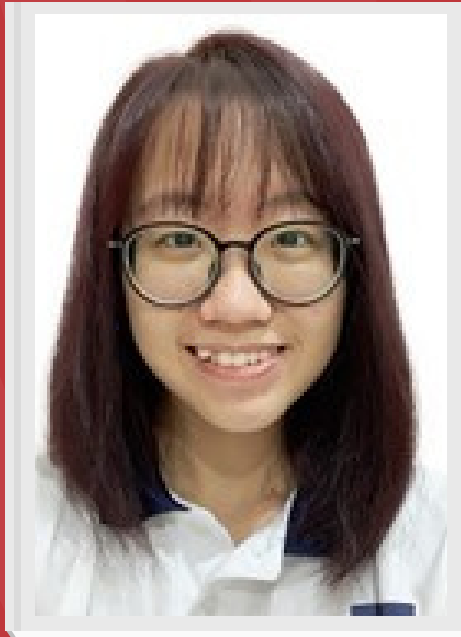

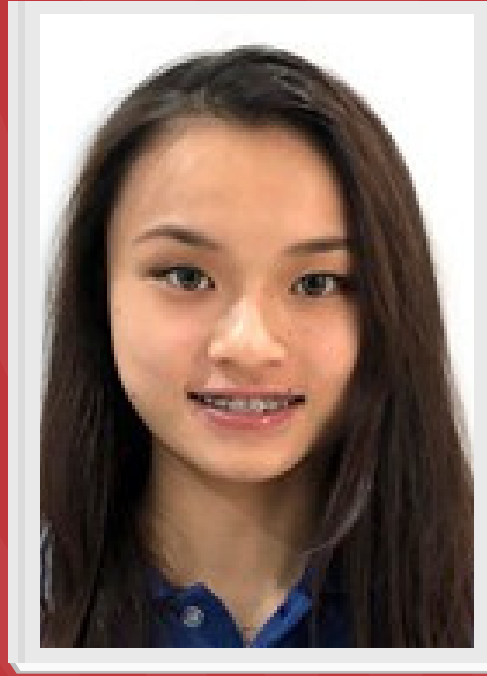
**Chinese Studies Society 2020/2021 Chairperson**

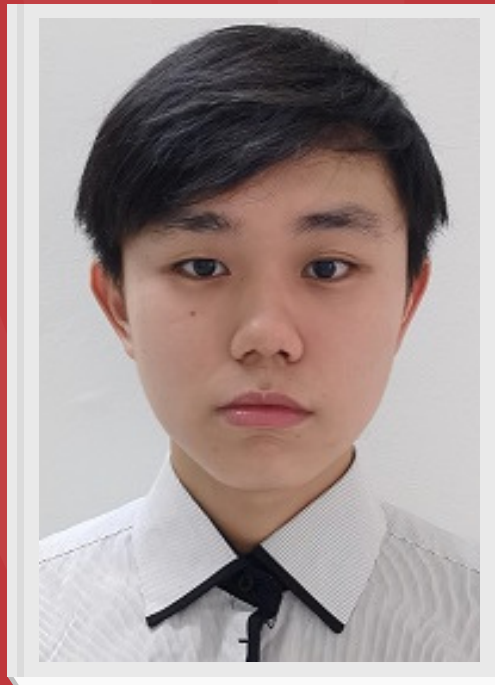

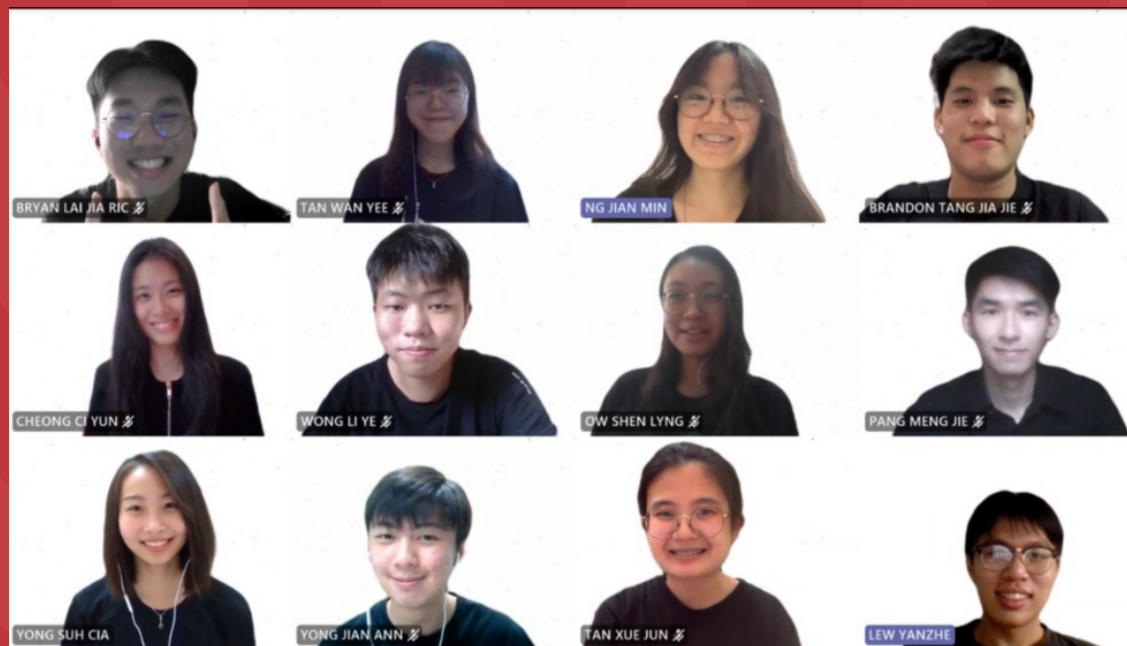

The Society put in a concerted effort to promote the spirit and knowledge of Medical and Health Sciences. The 221 members of the Medical and Health Sciences (MHSS) have been actively organising events that involved participation from UTARians, staff and students from other universities, and also members of the public. One of MHSS's successful feats was organising International Level events, namely the Virtual Mobility Programme: 'Medical, Cultural and Soft Skills Learning'. They also co-organised with Kenya for Virtual Federation African-Asian Medical Student' Exchange Programme (FAMSEP). Both these events attracted participation not only from students of local universities but also students from overseas universities. Medical and Health Sciences Society won 2nd Runner Up for the poster category and Special Mention Award for video category at the competitions in the Virtual Medic Inter-varsity Academic Olympiad (MIAO) 2020. Besides these two major events, MHSS and other clubs and societies successfully co-organised the Mental Health Program.

MHSS is very supportive of UTAR events and its contribution could be witnessed in 'Making an Informed Decision' and E-Convocation. The members were involved in a lot of volunteering projects such as Virtual Health Day, Hearts for Flood Donation Drive and Sign Language Workshop. These proactive members also participated in external events such as the MMI Memorandum: A Call for Resolution on Issues faced by Contract Medical Officers and My Community for Autism.

**The Chinese Language Society (CLS) is one of the most active societies in UTAR Sungai Long Campus with a total of 798 members. There are three (3) sub-groups under CLS, namely the Chinese Debate Team, Chinese Calligraphy and Diabolo. Each sub-group plays a diverse yet unified and dignified role. Every activity and event organised by the CLS members has garnered attention and participation from UTARians, staff and students from other universities and members of public. CLS had successfully organised two major events and they were the International Celebration of Virtual Chinese New Year Carnival and The Origins Charity Stage Drama, which received RM10 000.00 of sponsorship in total, had attracted approximately 470 participants.**

**CLS is also a very supportive society in UTAR Sungai Long Campus. There were lots of internal events with their apparent involvement such as the Debate, Calligraphy and Diabolo weekly activity. CLS is not only actively involved in UTAR internal events, but also in a myriad of external events. Past participation by CLS in notable external events were the Chinese New Year Celebration of Chinese Cultural Society Inti College, Pesta Angpau IPG and the National Traditional Chinese Calligraphy Awareness Movement.**
