

# **UTAR DRESS CODE FOR STUDENTS**

UTAR students shall be decently or appropriately attired while attending Lecture, Tutorial, Examination, Class, Workshop or while involving or attending any activities either inside or outside the campus or while present in any part of the campus.

Students must display their own Student Card at all times on Campus or in such manner on such occasions and at such times as may, from time to time, be directed by the University.

Students who do not dress appropriately or failed to display their own Student Card will be issued a written reminder and the offence will be recorded. Students who breached the University Dress Code and regulations for more than two (2) times shall be referred to the Student Disciplinary Committee for disciplinary actions.

(b) Students should follow UTAR dress code while attending academic activities (lecture, tutorial, practical, test, library, examination, teaching laboratory)

i. No tubes, halter tops. Spaghetti straps and shoulder straps should be at least 2" wide

# PANTS, SLACKS, SKIRTS

#### i. No shorts

ii. No mini-skirts and no tight skirts

iii. Dresses and skirts length should not be shorter than 3 inches above knees

iv. Clothing must not be ripped, torn, or contains noticeable holes. Ripped/torn jeans is acceptable but should not reveal the skin

v. Pants/ jeans for male and female should be at least 3/4 pant length
