- 3. Applicants are required to submit their most significant initiative / project throughout the pass assessment year (1 April 31 March).
- 4. The applicant must submit any relevant documents (i.e., proposals, reports, income statements) and photographic evidence where applicable for the identified initiative.
- 5. Applicants may be required to attend an interview if necessary.
